

# Using the NEH Funded Projects Query Web API

(updated December 2023)

You can use the NEH Funded Project Query form to search for any grant made by the agency. Queries can be constructed using our web-based form, the [Funded Project Query Form](#). In addition, you can construct your own queries using our API. To do so, you simply need to create a URL that contains the appropriate query parameters and values.

Here is a sample URL that uses most of the available parameters (copy and paste it into a browser to see the results). In the table below, we break out each parameter or search term you can use when constructing your querystring.

## NOTES

**Control Parameters.** The parameters in red are "control parameters." Every URL must contain all the control parameters (with one exception – see **Grant Number Query** below).

**Value Parameters.** The parameters in black are "value parameters." These contain the actual search values. They are only included in the URL if their corresponding control parameter is set to 1.

**Grant Number Query.** If you know the grant number (e.g. HD-50346-08), this query will return one and only one result. Therefore you do not need to use all the control parameters. Instead, you can use a simplified format for the query URL, as follows: <https://securegrants.neh.gov/publicquery/main.aspx?q=1&gn=HD-50346-08>

**Multiple Project Fields.** You can provide a list of project fields in your querystring, as in the example, instead of a single value. If the list is **comma-delimited** (&fv=3143,3133), the API will return results matching ANY of the values; if the list is **semicolon-delimited** (&fv=3140;3250;3259), it will return results matching ALL of the values.

**Percent Encoding.** Any text that contains spaces or reserved characters must be percent-encoded. In the above example, the phrase "University of Maryland, College Park" is percent-encoded to: "University+of+Maryland%2c+College+Park." For more information about percent-encoding, see [this Wikipedia article](#).

**Using a Subset of Parameters.** There is no need to use every parameter in each URL. In most cases, you would only query with the minimum number of fields to achieve the result set you are looking for. For example, to search for all grants in Alabama from 2000 to 2015, you would construct the following URL. Note that it includes all the control parameters; however, all are set to 0 except for the State (Alabama) and the Date Range control parameters, which are both set to 1, followed by the corresponding value parameters. **Value parameters are only included if their control parameter is set to 1.**

**Years-only Queries.** To prevent timeout errors, the API will not accept queries where the only parameters specified are dates and the date range is longer than six years. If you provide criteria in addition to the date range (as in the previous example), this limit is not enforced. So this URL will return a message that the limit has been exceeded:

**Hard-Coded Parameters (e.g. NEH divisions, project fields).** Some of the parameters must be hard-coded numeric values. For example, if you wish to search for projects only within a given NEH division or office, you can't pass the name of that office. Rather, you must know its numeric ID. The NEH Office of Digital Humanities has a value of 12, so in our current example, you see **&dv=12**. Note that while these numbers generally do not change, there is no guarantee that they won't. For some queries, you may wish to avoid hard-coded parameters if they aren't needed. As of this update (December 2023), here is the current list of NEH divisions and offices and their numeric IDs:

**Using the Funded Project Query Form.** You can use our [query form](#) to construct valid URLs as a way to gain a better understanding of the API and to troubleshoot your URLs. If you submit a query that cannot be parsed, the form will provide a link to the empty form where you can start a fresh query.

For multi-field queries, use comma-delimited list (fv=3181,3128) in querystring for ANY, semicolon-delimited list (fv=3181;3128) for ALL.
